Information at this stage

i) Inabilities to move left , upper and lower limbs- one month

ii) What Personal and treatment history you would to ask?

Part B

Conscious, oriented , tachypnoic

Pulse – 100/ m, irregularly irregular

BP 120/80mmhg, RR- 26/min , Temp – 101° F

Pallar +, jaundice+, clubbing+, cyanosis°, lymphnode°, odema +, JVP raised.

1. What other specific general examination findings you would like to search for

CVS: Silent features:

1. Apex beat (L) 6th intercostals space 2 cm lateral to mid clavicular line
2. Left parasternal pulsation seen
3. Left parasternal bulg present
4. pulsation seen(L) 2nd ICS
5. Systolic thrill at apex
6. Left parasternal heave present
7. Pan systolic murmur at apex
- 8 mid diastolic murmur at apex

Abdominal examination

1. Painful hepatomegaly
2. Painful splenomegaly

CNS: Left sided hemiparesis

What is your final diagnosis

Part C

HB : 10.0 gm TC: 18, 000, ESR 60 RFT – Normal, SB – 4.6 mg , CB – 1.4 mg , UB 3.2 Mg

Ultrasound abdomen, Echo, blood culture
