While all cultures share the same basic emotions, the forms of communication used throughout different cultures of the world vary enormously. What can mean one thing in one country, can often mean something completely different in another. For example, in North America and Europe people tend to prefer direct eye contact. The most apparently harmless gestures and customs—the thumbs-up sign, a casual greeting, certain types of gifts—can be radically misunderstood on foreign soil, with embarrassing or even dangerous consequences. Pointing with your finger is rude in so many countries it's probably wise just to abandon the gesture altogether overseas.
