On examination he has no any nervous abnormality detected. No H/o trauma to eyes, fever, deviation of angle of mouth, drooping of saliva. a) What is diagnosis and cause of disorder? b) What is the reason of weakness of muscle which improves after rest? c) What is the treatment for this disorder?
