Read the following passage carefully and answer any four questions given after it: "Jal, jungle, jameen" (water, forest, land) are the words that fill us with the image of the valiant tribal fighter, Komuram Bheem, fondly called 'Komuram Puli' (tiger). Born into a family of Gond tribals in the forests of Adilabad on 22 October, 1901, Bheem had no formal

education. But he understood the laws of nature so well that he declared that people who live in forests should have rights on all the resources (jal, jungle, jameen) of forests. For those basic rights for his people, he fought against the Asaf Jahi Dynasty. He took up arms against the Nizam Nawab soldiers and fought bravely for the rights of his tribes till he breathed his last on 8 October, 1940. Komuram Bheem lit the fire of liberation and remains a bright flame in the hearts of people.
