He has an Ultrasound report with him done recently elsewhere which is suggestive of a large mass in the pelvis which is more than 7 cms in size. Discuss
- Discuss options for a localized T2? N1 tumor of Ascending colon on a gentleman who is only 5 foot but weighs 100 kilograms. He is barely able to walk and his wife complains that he is sleepy all the time and snores a lot. The patient and the family are keen for minimally invasive option only.
