2. A 45 year old lady presented with painless lump in left iliac fossa. Give differential diagnosis. How will you investigate this patient? What are the indications of emergency surgery in a case of carcinoma descending colon? 3+4+3
3. A 50 year old male factory worker presented with non healing ulcer over medial aspect of leg. On examination, he had few dilated veins. Mention differential diagnosis, investigations and management of the patient. 2+3+5
4. A 25 year old female patient presented with haematemesis. Enumerate the differential diagnosis. Give an outline of her management. 4+6
5. A 40 year old male with history of recurrent urethral discharge presented with acute retention of urine. Briefly describe the differential diagnosis, investigations and management. 2+3+5
6. a) Classify fistula-in-ano. 4+6
b) Investigations and management of fistula-in-ano.
7. A 30 year old male presented with swelling left side of scrotum. Write the steps of clinical examination, differential diagnosis and management algorithm. 2+2+6
8. A 40 year old male recently diagnosed as a case of liver abscess presented with sudden severe respiratory distress. Enumerate the causes of respiratory distress in this patient. Briefly describe investigations and management. 2+(3+5)
