



The Indian Space Research Organisation boosted its reputation further when it successfully launched a record 104 satellites in one mission from Sriharikota on Wednesday by relying on its workhorse Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle rocket. An earth observation Cartosat-2 series and two other nano satellites were the only Indian satellites launched : the remaining were from the United States, Isreal, the UAE, the Netherlands, Kazakhstan and Switzerland. Of the 101 foreign satellites launched, 96 were from the U.S. and one each from the other five countries. Till now Russia held record of launching 37 satellites in a single mission, in 2014, while the National Aeronautics and Space Administration of the U.S. launched 29 satellites in one go in 2013. Last June, ISRO had come close to NASA's record by launching 20 satellites in one mission. But ISRO views the launch not as a mission to set a world record but as an opportunity to make full use of the capacity of the launch vehicle. The launch is particularly significant as ISRO now cements its position as a key player in the lucrative commercial space launch market by providing a cheaper yet highly reliable alternative. At an orbital altitude of around 500 km, the vehicle takes about 90 minutes to complete one orbit. Though ISRO had sufficient time to put the satellite into orbit, it accomplished the task in about 12 minutes. With the focus on ensuring that no two satellites collided with each other, the satellites were injected in pairs in opposite directions. Successive pairs of satellites were launched once the vehicle rotated by a few degrees, thereby changing the separation angle and time of separation to prevent any collision.

Roughly three-fourth of the shipments-expected to touch \$ 5 billion this year - are today accounted for by PUSA-1121, a high yielding variety breed by the Indian Agricultural Research Institute (IARI), which has an annual plan budget of hardly Rs. 60 crore. The same goes for cotton, where a more than two-and-a-half times jump in the country's output since 2002-03 has been courtesy transgene BT hybrids. Or for that matter maize, which has witnessed a doubling of production over the last 10 years with the advent of single cross hybrids.

These success stories are not merely about technological intervention translating into higher crop production and farm incomes. They also point to the crucial role of the private sector - be it seed companies, mollers, processors, or exporters - in ensuring effective transfer of research know how from laboratories to farmers' fields. In Bt-cotton and single-cross hybrids, the breeders were mainly private multinationals such as Monsanto and Dupont. They had every reason to aggressively 'push' these new cropping technologies. But PUSA-1121 would have remained in the IARI's research fields, but for a certain Basmati exporter who recognized its potential and took the initiative to promote the variety, both among farmers and overseas buyers. IARI has since come out with an improved Basmati variety; PUSA-1509, which also promises to be successful public sector breeding effort undertaken in close collaboration with exporting and farming community.

What these examples suggest is the need for a totally new Public-Private-Partnership (PPP) framework for agricultural R and D. This could involves the likes of IARI partnering with private seed companies for large-scale production and multiplication of publicly breed material in order to reach farmers. Such material can even be assigned on an exclusive, limited-period basis to make it commercially attractive to the companies concerned. The PPP approach could further extend to sponsored or joint research collaboration with industry, for example, breeding of barley varieties yielding more malt for breeding purpose or potatoes with less moisture and sugar content making them amicable for processing and frying. There is a lot of hidden value in public sector laboratories, which can be unlocked with research that is more "demand-driven" rather than being conducted in silos as is the care today. Equally, there is a need to move away from old-style breeding, relying on physical observation of plants, to the use of molecular biology and make assisted selection tools for identifying gene coding for specific traits. All this requires huge investments, making the case for collaboration much more compelling.
