

" TIBIALIS POSTERIOR MUSCLE "

- Tibialis Posterior is relative small Muscle located within the back of calf.
- TP is located within the **Posterior compartment** of leg.

Origin

- Originates from the upper $\frac{2}{3}$ of the back of the tibia lateral to **VERTICAL LINE** & below **SOLEAL LINE**
- Also from Medial $\frac{2}{3}$ of fibula,
- Deep transverse fascia.
- Interosseus Membrane.

Insertion

- Medial Malleolus of Tibia within the groove.
 - Medial Tendon
 - lateral Tendon

Splits Here. → into 2 part.

Medial Insertion is important Δ
is inserted to TUBEROSITY of
NAVICULAR BONE Δ MEDIAL CUNIFORM

#) lateral inserts into Cunioform as
well as 2nd, 3rd, 4th Metatarsal Bones.

NERVE

→ Posterior tibial Nerve

Action =)

- ① Inverts foot
- ② Plantar flexion
- ③ Maintains medial longitudinal Arch.
