2. What are the maternal and perinatal effects of pregnancy with systemic lupus erythematosus (SLE)? How would you monitor a woman with SLE during pregnancy, child birth and postpartum? (2+2)+(2+2+2)
3. How is amniotic fluid formed during pregnancy? Enumerate the causes of abnormal quantity of amniotic fluid. What are the complications of hydramnios? 3+4+3
4. Classify placenta praevia. What are the causes of placenta praevia? How will you confirm its diagnosis? What are problems in its management? 3+2+2+3
5. What are predisposing factors for breech presentation? How will you manage such a case presenting at 36 weeks? 3+7
