7. Write important characteristics of Type D personality. Discuss briefly about its relevance and implications. 4+6
8. What is treatment resistant depression? Discuss briefly assessment and treatment of treatment resistant depression. 2+(4+4)
9. Discuss briefly clinical presentations, differential diagnosis and management of fronto-temporal dementia. 4+3+3
10. What are the common causes and methods of committing suicide in India? Discuss management of suicidal attempt in a young lady brought to Emergency services in your hospital. (2+2)+6
