  Enumerate various conditions associated with polypoidal lesions in the large bowel. How will you distinguish between
- benign and malignant polyp on imaging? Discuss the merits and demerits of virtual CT colonoscopy in a case of suspected familial polyposis coli.
- 3. Enumerate the causes of arterial phase enhancing focal lesions in the liver. Discuss the role of MDCT and MRI in differential diagnosis of these lesions.
- 4. A 40 year old female with pain abdomen is found to have a cyst in the body of pancreas on ultrasound. Enumerate various possible causes. Discuss the imaging algorithm you would follow for arriving at diagnosis in this case.
- 5. A forty year old female patient presented with complaint of vague right lumbar pain. An ultrasound revealed a cystic lesion in right kidney. She was advised to undergo CT scan by the radiologist for further evaluation. Enumerate possible causes. Discuss the CT protocol and findings in various lesions.
- 6. Enumerate the causes of a palpable lumbar mass in a five year old child. Discuss the algorithmic approach you would use to arrive at diagnosis in this case.
- 7. Define habitual abortion. Enumerate various causes of habitual abortion. Discuss the role of imaging in diagnosis and follow up of these cases.
