- A 3 Week old neonate presents with failure to thrive and severe stridor, present since birth.
  What are the causes of airway obstruction, outline investigations and management
- 2. 32 weeks preterm is delivered after PPROM 1.5 KGS is ventilated for RDS, received surfactant. Baby fails extubation twice on day 3 and day 6. Discuss how do you would analyse causes for extubation failure?
- A Term neonate, weighing 1.8 KGS, presents with seizures on day 3. Outline causes and management
- A 2 day old well neonate is brought in with multiple petichae. Platelet count is noted to be low. Discuss causes of throbocytopenia in a well neonate. Add a note on NAIT
- When do you diagnose H₅PDA in a preterm baby? Discuss medical management. Add a note on recent advances in surgical treatment
- A 3 day old neonate presents with gross abdominal distension, bilious vomiting and delayed passage of meconeum. Discuss investigations and treatment
- A Term baby is delivered to a HIV positive mother, WHO is newly diagnosed (NOT RECEIVED ART). How will you manage this neonate to prevent PTCT?
- 8. Write a note on prevention of hospital acquired infection in NICU
- Clinical diagnosis, relevant investigations of a baby with PPHN. Add a note on pulmonary vasodilator therapy
- 10. Write briefly on organization of high risk follow up clinic in a tertiary care center
