- 1. A 55 year old man with history of smoking, Hypertension is brought to Emergency OPD with complaints of severe retrosternal chest pain radiating to left arm and jaw. He also had nausea, vomiting, profuse sweating and shortness of breath. ECG showed ST segment elevation and diagnosed to have Ischaemic Heart disease. Write a note on anatomical basis of Ischaemic heart disease. Describe origin, course and branches of coronary arteries.
- 2. A previously healthy 24 year old female presented with severe pain and acute facial swelling associated with fever. She was diagnosed to have viral infection of Parotid gland. Describe the external features, contents, relations, nerve supply and duct of parotid gland. What is the anatomical basis behind severe pain in parotid swelling?
