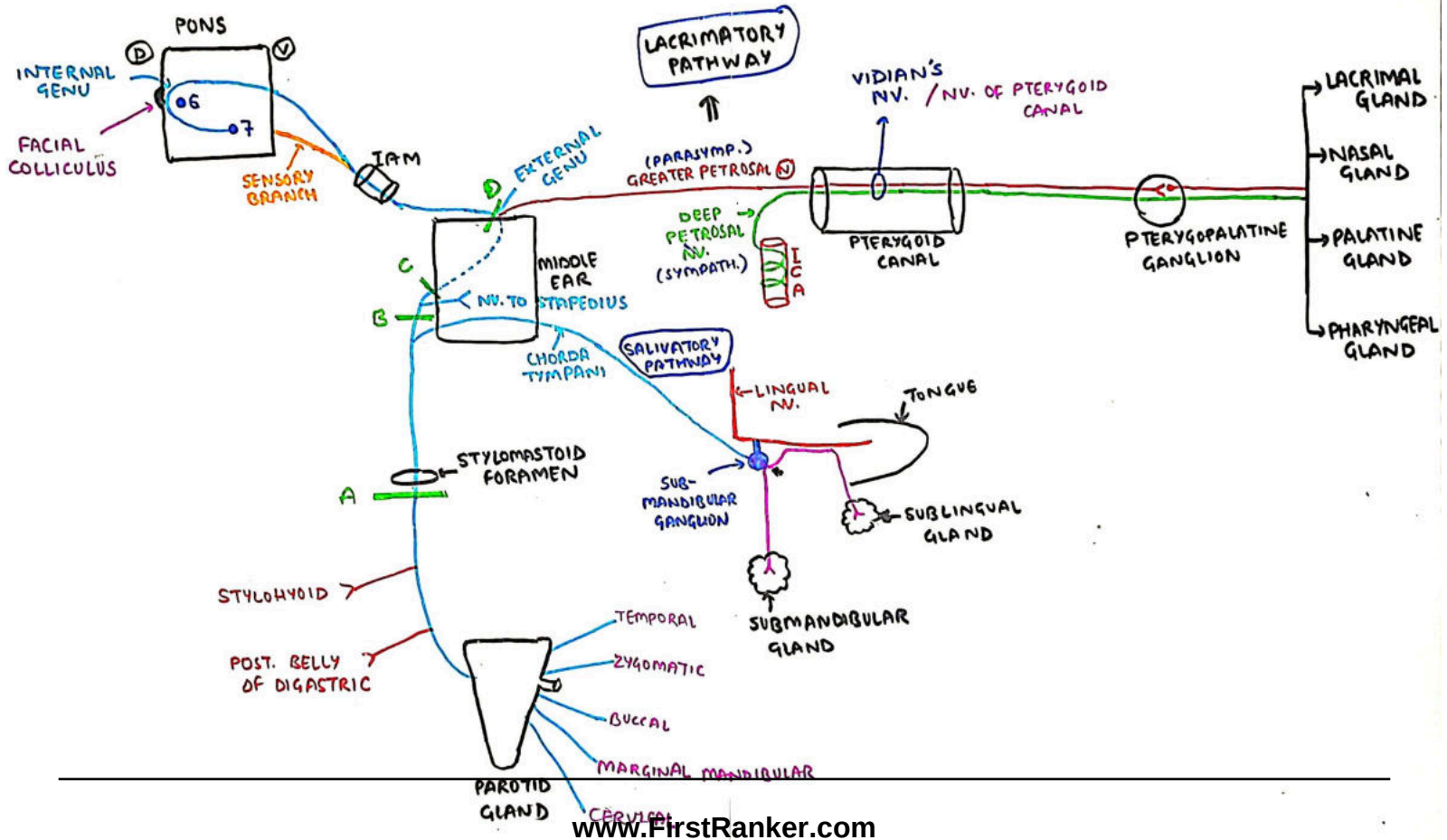

LESION

CLINICAL FEATURES

A) AT STYLOMASTOID FORAMEN

FACIAL PALSY

B) ABOVE CHORDA TYMPANI

A + DECREASED SALIVATION + LOSS OF TASTE FROM ANT. $\frac{2}{3}$ OF TONGUE

C) ABOVE NV. TO STAPEDIUS
↓ INTENSITY OF SOUND

B + HYPERACUSIS
(∵ NV. TO STAPEDIUS GONE)

D) AT EXTERNAL GENU

C + LOSS OF LACRIMATION
