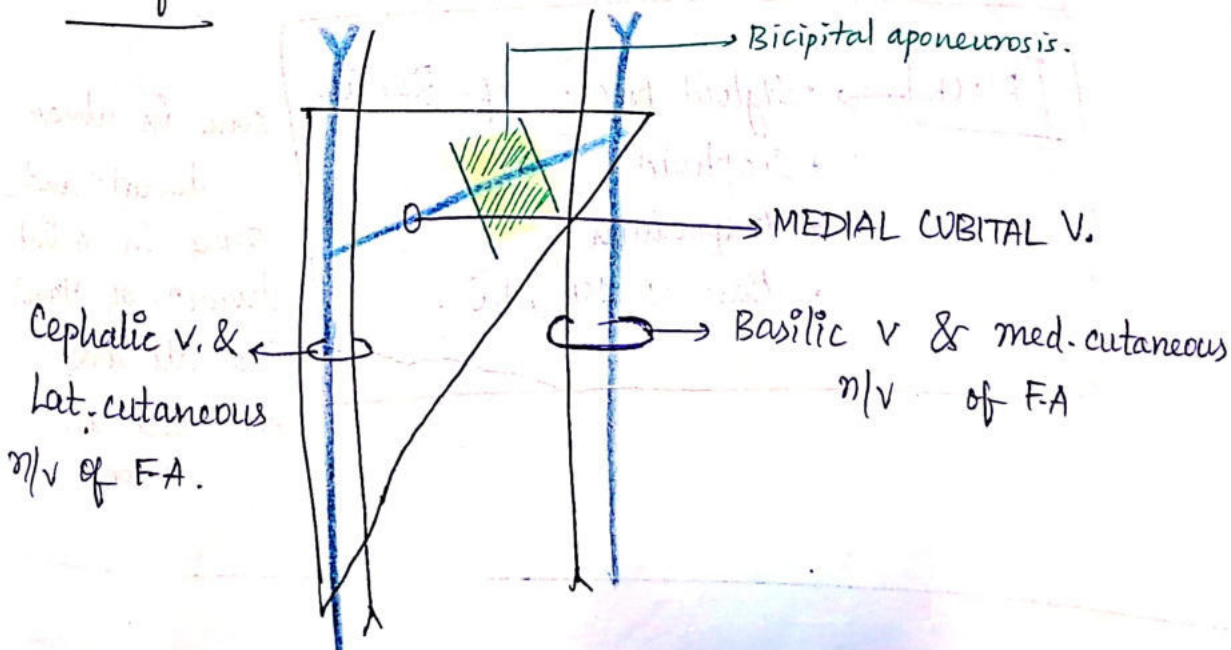
- 1) Brachialis (upper part)

- rests on Bicipital aponeu. & conn. to it by PERFORATORS
- used for intravenous injection bcoz protected from B.A. by Bicipital aponeurosis.

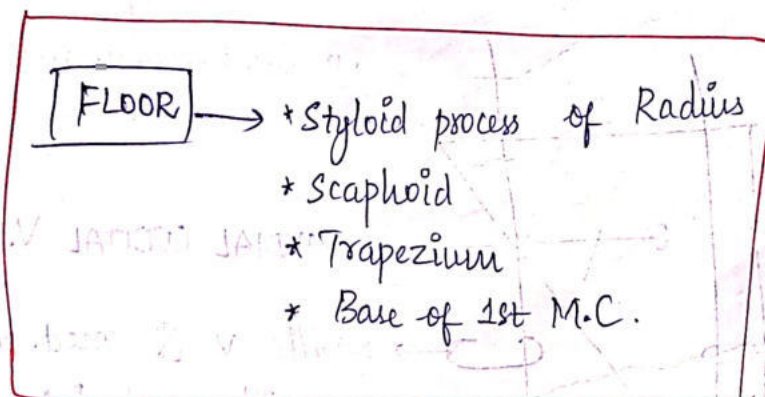
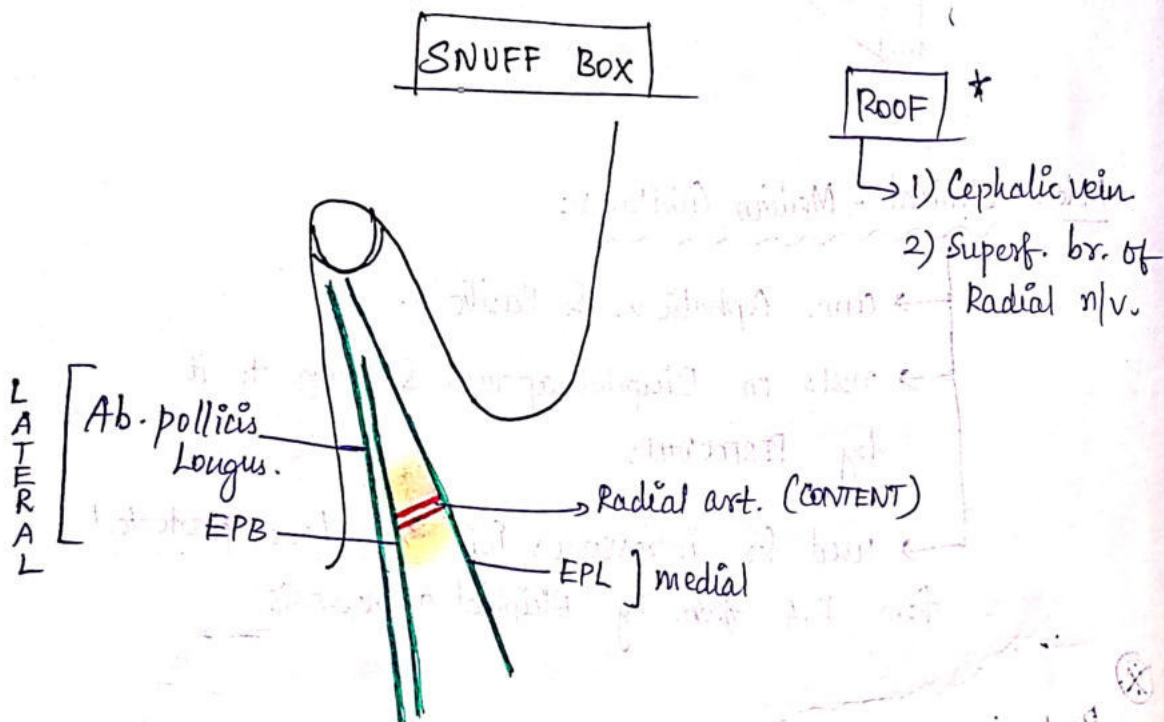

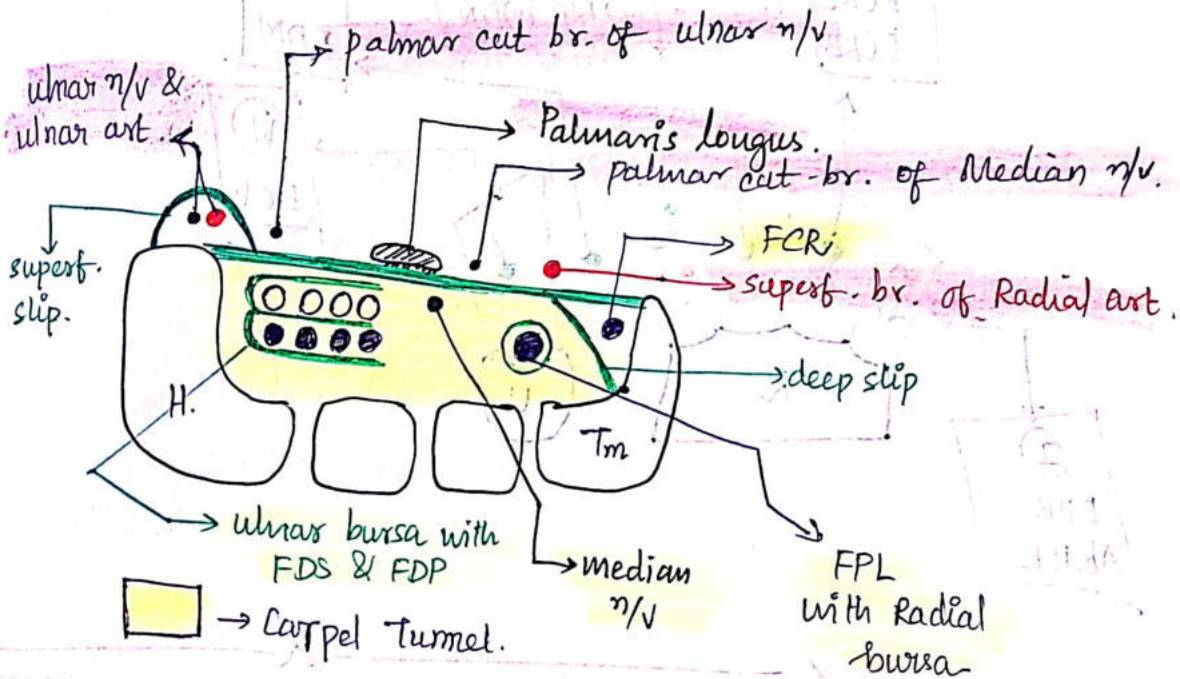
B — Brachial art.
